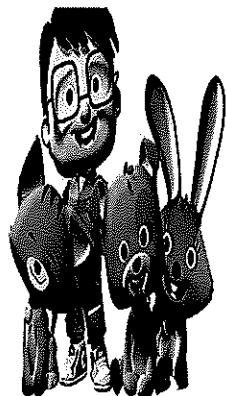

From the Pastor's desk,

What's important? What is it that we toil for in the world? Do we desire recognition or wealth or power? Do you own your possessions or do your possessions own you? The first reading and the Gospel speaks to this trap. We also have the words of our Holy Father Francis speaking about this in our current time. The wisdom and word of God is greater than the baubles and foibles of the world. St. Paul says that the words of God are like a sword "penetrating between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow". Left to our own devices, we are unable to overcome our dependency on the world. We are unable to break the shackles that binds us to the cycle of "keeping up with the Jones'." Alone, by ourselves, under our own power, it is impossible. Jesus confirms this and offers His solution. "All things are possible for God." He can overcome. He can break the shackles. The young man in the Gospel followed the commandments. He said, "All of these, I have observed [done] since my youth." The man was good and Jesus loved him for it. But he could not follow Jesus because he was owned by his possessions. Do not be owned by the world. Be not afraid. Cling to Christ and trust Him for all things are possible for Him.
