From the Pastor's Desk,

“Up in the morning and out to school.”

~Chuck Berry, “School Daze”

For most of our families, we enter the last week of summer vacation. Though school does not start for another week, it will dominate our time. School supplies, school clothes, signups, earlier bedtimes, earlier rising times, and don't forget CCD. Education is very important. We want our children to grow in knowledge and experience. Reading, writing, math, science; all taken in order to prepare our youth for the world of adulthood; you know, the “real world.” Think of all the preparation that we expend for school; think of all the time that is invested in education. Time well spent, assuredly. Five days a week, 7-8 hours a day not counting homework, is spent in school. In order to prepare them for the world. Now for the rhetorical question: How many hours do we spend, how much emphasis and encouragement do we give our children, to prepare them for the “real world” with **FAITH**?
