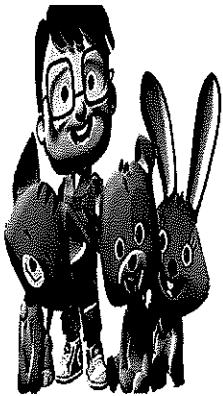
**Canned Food Drive**
