**From the Pastor's Desk,**  
On Monday, January 25, the Church celebrates the conversion of St. Paul. We all know his story: Paul was a Jew and was rounding up Christians for trial and execution when he had a direct encounter with Christ. Subsequently, Paul learned the teachings of Christ from the Apostles, was baptized, and then sent to preach the gospel to the Gentiles. (You can read about this in the Acts of the Apostles 9: 1 – 31.) I think often of a non-Catholic becoming Catholic. But actually, even as Catholics already, we are still called everyday to a conversion of heart. Everyday and every moment we should strive to sin less and to live according to the teachings of Christ, viz. love God and love your neighbor. Just as St. Paul had a direct encounter with Christ which led to his conversion and spreading the gospel, every Sunday we have the same direct encounter and it should drive us to a conversion of the heart.
