FYI: On Tuesday, July 11,2017 there was an attempted abduction of a child from the Vacation Bible School at St. Anthony of Padua in Palacios.

The Office of Safe Environment with the Diocese of Victoria and the Palacios Police Department were notified. This case is being handled by the Palacios police Department.

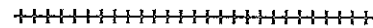
The subject was described as a middle aged, Hispanic female in her 40’s – 5-“s with grey hair shoulder length hair. The subject was wearing pink pants and a shirt with fruit on it. The child was approached as the Vacation Bible School dismissed and was offered candy and Sea World tickets. The child was able to get away safely and notify an adult. The Palacios Police Department also mentioned that 2 demales have benn seen in the Palacios area for the last week walking and selling ice cream and/or candy to lure children.

The Diocese of Victoria works diligently to protect all children who are entrusted to their care. There are safe guards, policies and procuders in place to ensure the safety and welfare of all childre, which is of upmost importance. The Diocese of Victoria will immediately evalute this incident as a precaution inform all it’s parishes and schools.

Parents shild take time to remind their children of these safety tips:

1. Do not talk to strangers.
2. Be aware of your surroundings (example: Don’t focus your attention on your cell phone while walking home from school. Walk with your head up looking at your surroundings).
3. Stick together. There is safety in numbers.
4. Practice basic self – defense. A swift kick to the shins or private parts along with a loud scream will help get the attention of people in the area.
5. If you’re at home alone – lock your doors.
6. If something happens to you, report it immediately!
